One of the Smart Growth tools utilized by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs is a process of bringing local and regional planning resources including economic development and environmental experts and consultants together with residents and elected officials to generate plans around local growth plans. Quality Growth Resource Teams are local technical assistance visits sponsored by the Georgia Quality Growth Partnership (GQGP) and staffed by volunteers from the partnership, the state university system, and public or private sector participants from the design, planning, or development fields.
